School Facts

Crossroads FLEX High School, established in 2016, is one of twenty-eight high schools within the Wake County Public School System, North Carolina designed to serve between 100-125 students. The Wake County School System is the 16th largest public school system in the U.S. with almost 160,000 students. Located in Cary, NC the community is a rapidly growing area composed of multi-suburban and small-town families that border the capital city of Raleigh and the Research Triangle Park. Crossroads FLEX High School is a digital, blended learning school in which students take courses online in conjunction with seat time with certified teachers.

Crossroads FLEX serves students whose outside interests and activities require considerable amounts of time during regular school hours, known at Crossroads FLEX as “pursuits”. This can include students who are highly competitive and/or active in the arts, sports, or have other obligations such as extensive work schedules or family commitments. Partnering with North Carolina Virtual Public Schools, blended learning is using both online and in-person learning experiences when teaching students. Students work independently on online lessons, projects, and assignments at home and at Crossroads FLEX. Students meet with teachers to review their learning progress, discuss their work, ask questions, or receive assistance with difficult concepts while meeting a required amount of seat time. Crossroads FLEX is designed to allow students to meet those obligations while meeting all requirements for high school graduation, as well as college and career readiness.

The school offers a full complement of arts, English, math, second languages, science, social studies, physical education, and career and technical courses.

Class Rank

Transcripts reflect both weighted and unweighted cumulative grade-point averages. Class rank is based on the weighted cumulative grade-point average. Honors credit is awarded for transfer honors courses if honors credit is awarded at Crossroads FLEX High School.

Graduation Requirements

26 credits

- English = 4 credits
- Math = 4 credits including Algebra I/Math I
- Science = 3 credits
- Social Studies = 4 credits
- Physical Education = 1 credit (Healthful Living)
- Electives = 10 credits
